Dear Mr. Hamid,

On June 20, 2023, I filed an *ex parte* letter in the above dockets. In that letter, I discussed the steps FailSafe Communications, Inc. ("FailSafe") was making toward a demonstration of Telesentient® technology for the Staff. On July 14, 2023, I updated that letter to inform you that the GIS provider we intended to utilize for that demonstration was the Pacific Disaster Center ("PDC").

The PDC is located in south Maui, Hawaii. In early August, 2023, a series of devastating fires hit west Maui. While the PDC headquarters itself was not damaged, the PDC kicked into emergency disaster recovery mode for its neighbors. As a result, all efforts for FailSafe have been put "on hold."

Therefore, FailSafe would like to propose two demonstrations. We are in the process of preparing a demonstration of basic FailSafe technology and would propose a demonstration in Washington, D.C. in mid to late September. FailSafe anticipates that the PDC would be able to resume its work on this project in October. We would propose a further demonstration at the PDC's headquarters in Maui as soon as that work is ready. As the Staff is aware, most of Maui is still open for business and is needing tourist revenue. We believe a trip to Maui by the FCC and its staff would demonstrate the Commission's continued support for the people of Maui.

We need your assistance with the logistics of these demonstrations. For the DC demonstration, please let us know how many Staff members are likely to attend. Would the Staff members be primarily technical, legal or executive? Would we be able to do the demonstration at FCC headquarters, or should we find an alternative location? What would be the most convenient day for the demonstration?

For the Maui demonstration – how many Commissioners or Staff might be able to attend? Can FailSafe supplement the Commission's travel budget for such a trip? Can FailSafe assist in making hotel reservations and local transportation?

We are excited to meet all of you in person and look forward to making both presentations to you. Please have someone call me at (512) 689-7815 to work on the logistics of the presentations.
